

Our venue

Ardeonaig is a former shooting lodge set in 20 acres of beautiful Highland Perthshire, high above Loch Tay, with stunning views across the water to the mountains beyond – and it's less than two hours drive from Edinburgh. There's comfortable bunk-bedded accommodation for up to 56 people (1 single room, 4 twins, 1 triple, 7 four-bed, 3 five-bed, and 1 seven-bed room.**)
There is a sports centre with sports hall and games room, and two cosy lounges to relax in, with great views and log fires.

Our stay is fully catered (including hot chocolate and cake before bed!), and we don't have to do any cleaning before we leave.

Our theme

We're going to be exploring (and experiencing!) what Sabbath means – setting aside time to rest, play, be creative, think, and connect with each other and with God, in activities, in eating together and in stillness and quiet.

Programme

Our programme will aim to provide enough fun for everyone, but also space to relax and just 'be'. Activities may include communal singing, photography, seminars, silent walking, exploring the Enneagram, geocaching, compline, ceilidh, sunrise service, indoor/outdoor games, film, Sunday worship, and lots of eating, as well as the organized centre activities which include canoeing, archery and ropes course.

The weekend will begin with an evening meal at 7pm on Friday, and end after lunch on Sunday. If you have children who need to eat earlier than 7pm on the Friday, please state this, and any other requirements, on the back of the booking form.
